- **KIV-7M Link Encryptor**

- This is a hands-on intensive course where students perform realistic setup and operation exercises required to perform functional administrative and configuration tasks associated with the KG-175A GigE and KG-175D Micro.
- The TACLANE combination course is designed to provide the skills necessary to load, operate, maintain, and establish connectivity within the SIPRNet Ethernet network environment.
- The course includes extensive hands-on exercises in configuration and implementation, as well as troubleshooting exercises that introduce faults into student generated networks in order to experience real-world, real-time problem resolution.
