Bullseye enables more accurate target development, improved workflows, business process analytics, targeting strategy generation, and assessment. This web-based tool offers capabilities to build and publish "living" target systems analyses (TSA), area of interest study (TSS), and manage target development nomination (TDN) processes performed at combatant command targeting production centers. Bullseye has been developed to enable cohesive collaboration across the joint targeting lifecycle as an intelligence support tool for the joint targeting suite of applications. Deployment is flexible to work on multiple platforms - from a single laptop to a server, to cloud.

Bullseye provides joint force commanders with precise targeting recommendations exploiting multiple domains. This multi-domain perspective on adversary systems will provide rich targeting options including both kinetic and non-kinetic solutions.
